GAMING MACHINES REGULATIONS 2005: REGULATION 10

NOTICE OF EXEMPTION BY THE MINISTER FOR BUSINESS SERVICES AND CONSUMERS

*(Persons Storing Gaming Machines Owned by the Holder of the
Casino Licence under the Casino Act 1997)*

NOTICE

PURSUANT to Regulation 10 of the Gaming Machines Regulations 2005, I, the Minister for Business Services and Consumers:

1. Grant to the following persons an exemption from Section 45 (offence of being unlicensed) of the Gaming Machines Act 1992:

(a) a person storing gaming machines owned by the holder of the casino licence under the Casino Act 1997.

2. Declare that the exemption under Clause 1 is subject to the conditions in Regulation 10 (4bb) of the Gaming Machines Regulations 2005.
