

## Approved Market List – Application

### *Liquor Licensing Act 1997, section 39(5)*

Section 39(5) of the Liquor Licensing Act 1997 (the Act) gives the Licensing Authority the power to endorse a liquor production and sales (LPS) licence with an authorisation to sell or supply liquor at approved markets for consumption on (e.g. sampling or seated at a table) or off (takeaway sales in sealed containers) the site of the market. LPS licences are typically held by local South Australian producers of wine, beer, gin or other spirits.

The licensing authority maintains a list of approved markets which can be found on the CBS website at <https://www.cbs.sa.gov.au/resources/approved-markets>. Any LPS licence with this authorisation can sell or supply liquor at any market on the Approved Markets list. This will generally occur pursuant to an agreement/arrangement between the licensee and the market organiser.
